

First Condition – if + simple present, will future

1. If Caroline and Sue prepare the salad, Phil will clean the house
2. If Sue cuts the onions for the salad, Caroline will peel the carrots.
3. Jane will vacuum the room if Ron moves the furniture.
4. If Bob cleans the kitchen, Anita will clean the bathroom.
5. If I do this test, I will improve my English.
6. Peggy will go shopping if she has time today.
7. If Simon gets a cheap airfare, he will go to London tomorrow.
8. Linda will leave her boyfriend if he does not call her today.
9. If they don't study harder, they will flunk the course.
10. I will not have to water the lawn if it rains tomorrow.

Second Condition – if + simple past, would (not) + verb

1. If I played the lottery, I would have a chance to win.
2. I'd be rich, if I won the lottery.
3. If I were rich, it would change my life.
4. I would buy an island, if I were rich.
5. If I lived on my own island, I would build a big house.
6. I would invite all my friends, if I built a house on my island.
7. I would sail my friends around on my yacht, if I had one.
8. We would have great parties, if my friends came to my island.
9. If we wanted to go shopping, we would charter a helicopter.
10. When my friends finished their vacations and leave, I would feel very lonely.

Third Conditional – if + past perfect, would (not) + have + past participle

1. If the midfielders had played better, we would have won the game.
2. If the forwards had moved faster, they would have scored more goals.
3. The players would have been more confident, if they had scored a field goal in the first half.
4. The goalie would have caught the ball, if he had jumped higher.
5. If the referee had seen the foul, he would have awarded a penalty kick to our team.
6. Our team would have been in better form if they had trained harder during the off-season.
7. The game would have been closer if the coach had substituted players more often.
8. If it had been a home game we would have won the game.
9. If our team had won the match we would have moved up in the league standings.
10. If I hadn't eaten so much pizza before the match I would not have thrown up on the field.
