\* "Dare", "need", and "ought" do not require the auxiliary verb (do) when they are used in a negative sentence, where the negative (not) is placed after one of these verbs.

You can use the auxiliary verb (do) in a negative sentence if you order the words of the sentence in its normal form. Examples:

- I need to go to the school.
- I need not go to the school.
- I do not need to go to the school.
